VIDEO INSTRUCTIONS

Welcome to DVD Video from RPM! Top Hits U.S.A. VIDEO is for club, hospitality & retail atmosphere applications. **This is no ordinary DVD!**

The RPM Video Hits series includes advanced DVD features. This sheet will tell you how to use every feature. *Due variations in DVD players, features may work differently or not at all on your player. Check for proper operation of each feature before using it in a critical application.*

Some of the advanced features on RPM DVD's:

- 1) Automatic play start and loop on disc insertion.
- 2) Menu selection of Tracks, Mixes and Format Types.
- 3) Selection of loop or individual play of tracks.
- 4) Clean & "Super-Clean" mixes for young audiences.



Important information is provided on the DVD Insert Sheet provided with each DVD issue. **If an Insert Sheet is missing**, you can print out a replacement sheet by visiting our web site at www.tophitsusa.com.

Upon Disc Insertion: When you first insert the disc, it will automatically begin playing all 25 tracks in a loop from track 1 to 25. The loop will continue until you stop the DVD or press the "Menu" button.

Press Menu or Disc Menu Button: Displays main menu. At the top of the menu is the issue date for the DVD and an explanation of the setting of the main virtual control "knob". From here you can select:

[Tracks](#) [Mixes](#) [Formats](#)

If you select TRACKS: The menu will move to the Tracks list. You can select and play any of the 25 tracks on the DVD with the option of [Continuous](#) or [Individual](#) play. **If you select continuous**, the player will play the track you selected then continue playing all other tracks in order. It will keep playing the entire list in loop until you stop the DVD or hit the Menu button. **If you select Individual**, the player will play the track you selected then return to the menu and wait for you to select another track. **IMPORTANT: Some players incorporate a timeout that will begin playing the first track on the DVD if you do not make a selection in a certain period of time.**

If you select MIXES: The Mixes Menu is displayed where you can select from five prepared mixes. When you select a mix, the player will begin playing the tracks assigned to that mix in a predetermined order. The player will continue to repeat the selected mix until you stop the player or hit "Menu". The mixes provided are:

[Soft to Hot Mix](#)

Soft to Hot Mix: All 25 tracks are played in order of lowest to highest tempo. This mix, along with serial play from track 1-25 gives you two built-in ways to play every track on the DVD without having to make any further commands.

Mature Mix: Only the most intense and adult-oriented tracks are played.

Clean Mix: All tracks are carefully screened for content, both based on actual language and visual image as well as the message of each video production. This mix is suitable for young audiences.

Super-Clean Mix: Similar to the Clean mix but with very strict standards. Videos in the Super-Clean category are suitable for young audiences.

Up/Dance: This mix takes the most energetic Up-Tempo and Dance tracks and arranges them in a great high-energy mix.

If you select FORMATS: You can select from five formats. When you select a format, the player will play all of the tracks on the DVD assigned that format. The formats are identified on the DVD insert sheet:

[Pop](#) [Rock](#) [RAP](#) [Dance](#) [Adult](#)

When you select a Format, the player will play the tracks assigned to that format in a loop until you stop the player or hit the "Menu" button.

CleanGuard Control: Restricts play to tracks in the Clean & Super-Clean mixes. To activate, set your DVD player Parental Control to Level 1 or "G" rating. The player will permit play of only the Clean or Super-Clean Mix. No other menu options will be displayed. **CAUTION: Some DVD players may ignore the setting. Be sure to test your player before releasing the DVD for play.**
